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# Current issues & evolutions in Nursing in my country

## From 2020 we have in Germany different ways to become a "NURSE"

1. B. Sc. Nursing, 3,5 years, 210 ECTS and 2320 hours in the practical fields (400 hours in acute care and long-term care) (varying in different parts of Germany: ECTS and number of semester because of the federal education system!)
2. General nurse (diploma nurse), vocational qualification, 3 years at school and salary
3. until 2028 it's possible to continue the old ways (Pediatric nurse , nurse for adult, and nurse for elderly people (3 years at school + salary) or the "old" B. Sc. combined with salary from a hospital partner like our "old" system in Berlin)



- Our old system **at our** university will end 2023!
- In 2020 we will start with the new study course and the new curriculum
